### **Uniform**

Just a quick note about uniform now that warmer weather is with us.

Many pupils like to wear a fashionable jacket over or instead of their blazer. The effect is to make it look as if they go to a school that does not have a blazer as part of its uniform. But we do wear blazers here.

At this point of the year it is too warm to need to wear a coat over a blazer and so pupils only really need to bring a light coat to school in case of rain. But we do not expect to see any pupils wearing their coats from now until the end of the year. If we do see a pupil wearing a coat we will confiscate it and return it to him/her at the end of the week. Likewise pupils must not now wear hats, gloves or scarves.

All pupils must wear their blazers to school but we may let them take their blazer off if it gets very hot in classrooms or in the playground.

Because there may be times when we let pupils remove their blazers, until the end of the year we want pupils to wear their school badges on their ties.

Shirts must still be tucked in and ties must still be worn.
