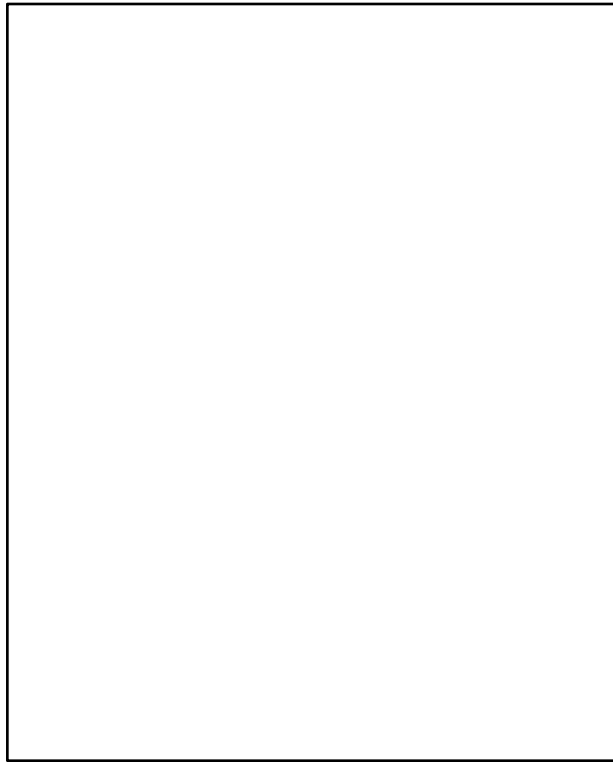
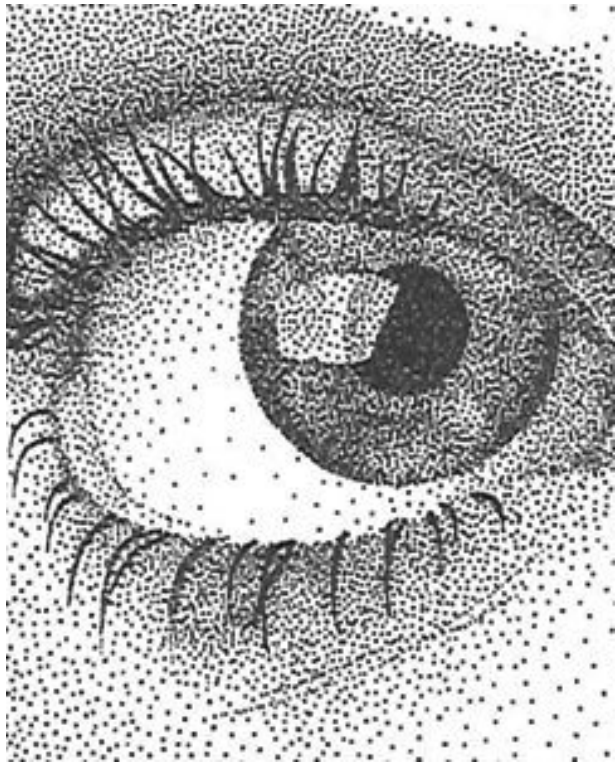
Independent Task:

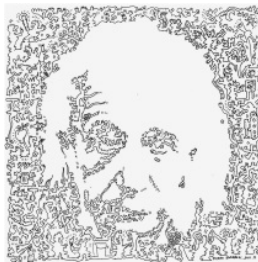


Year 9 Homework Booklet- Task 2

Independent Task:

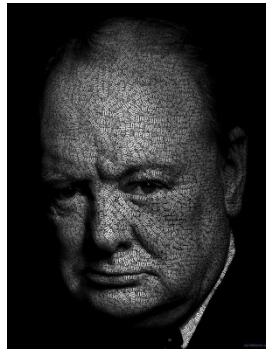

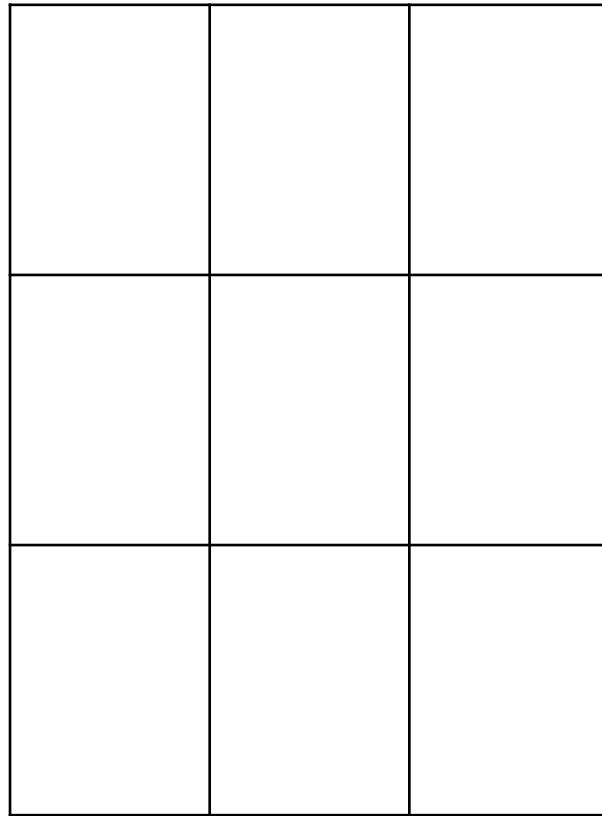
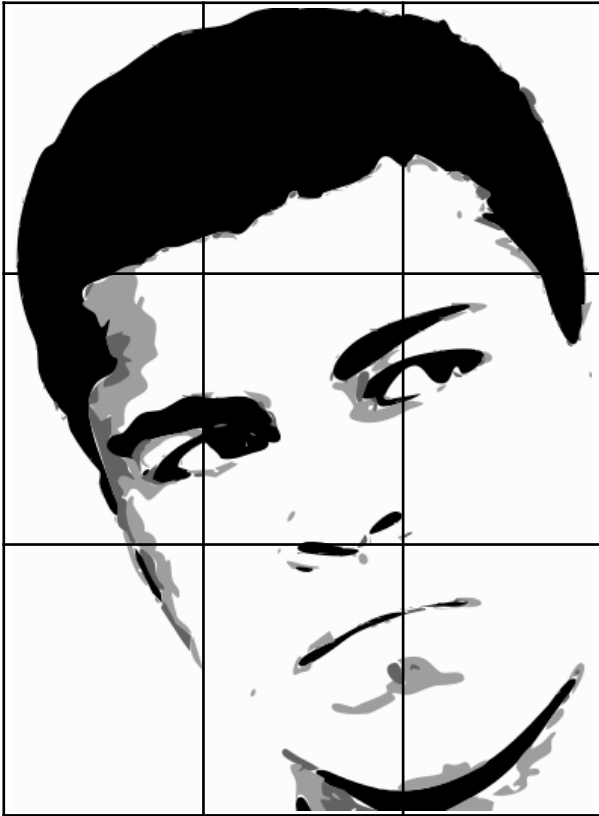
Independent Task:

Draw: Imitate this drawing . Use the **grid method** to help you sketch the outline in **proportion**. Add tone using pencil or felt tip.

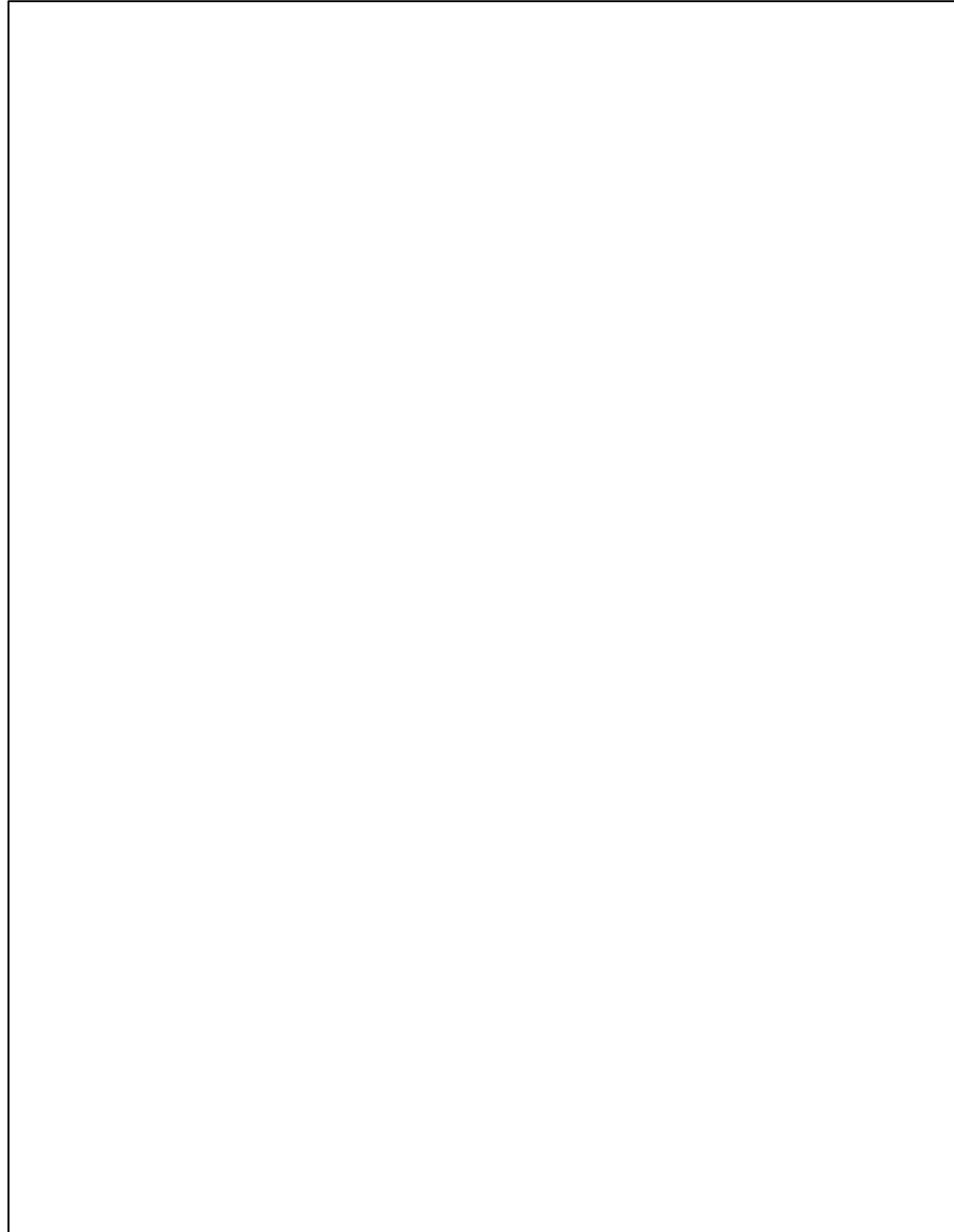

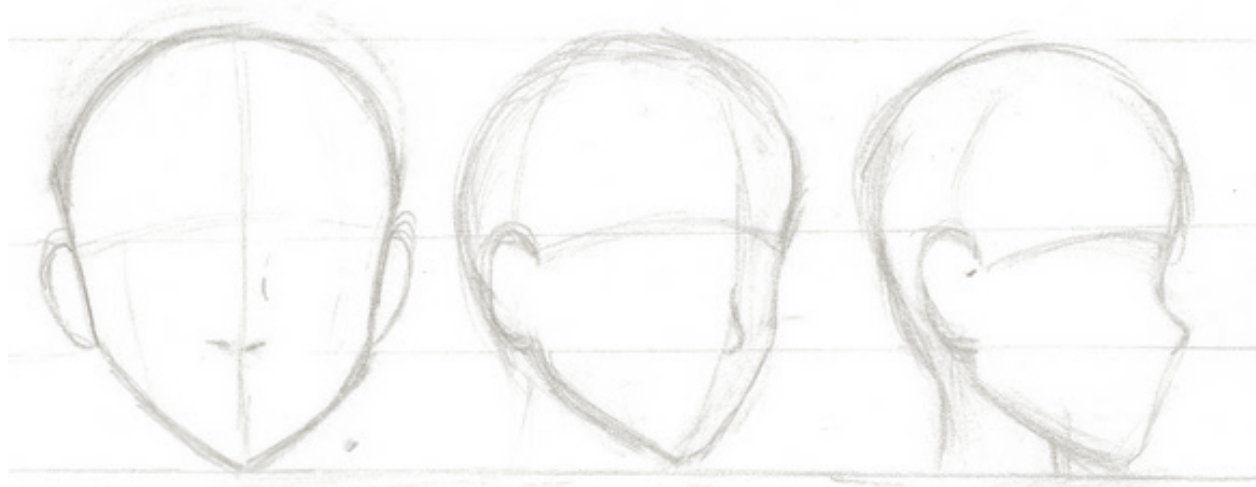

Information: Who is Masashi Kishimoto and how did he become so well known? Watch him draw live on YouTube.

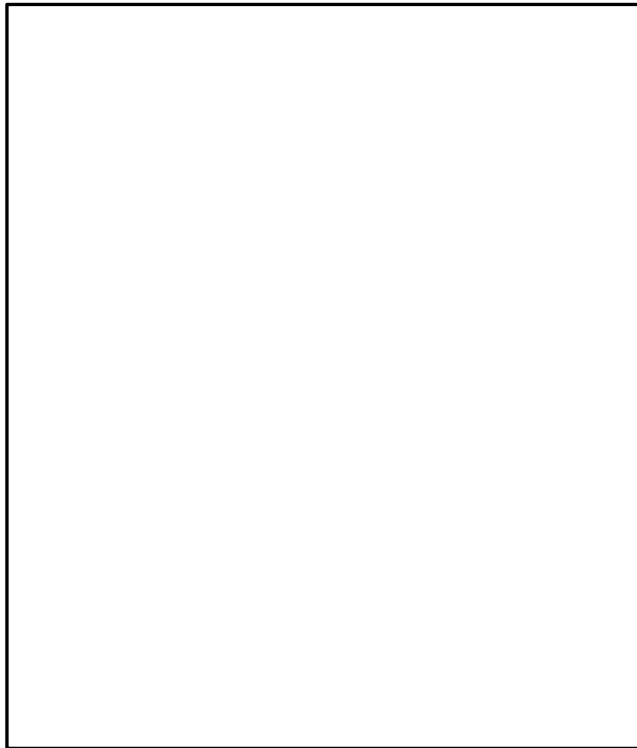
Independent Task:

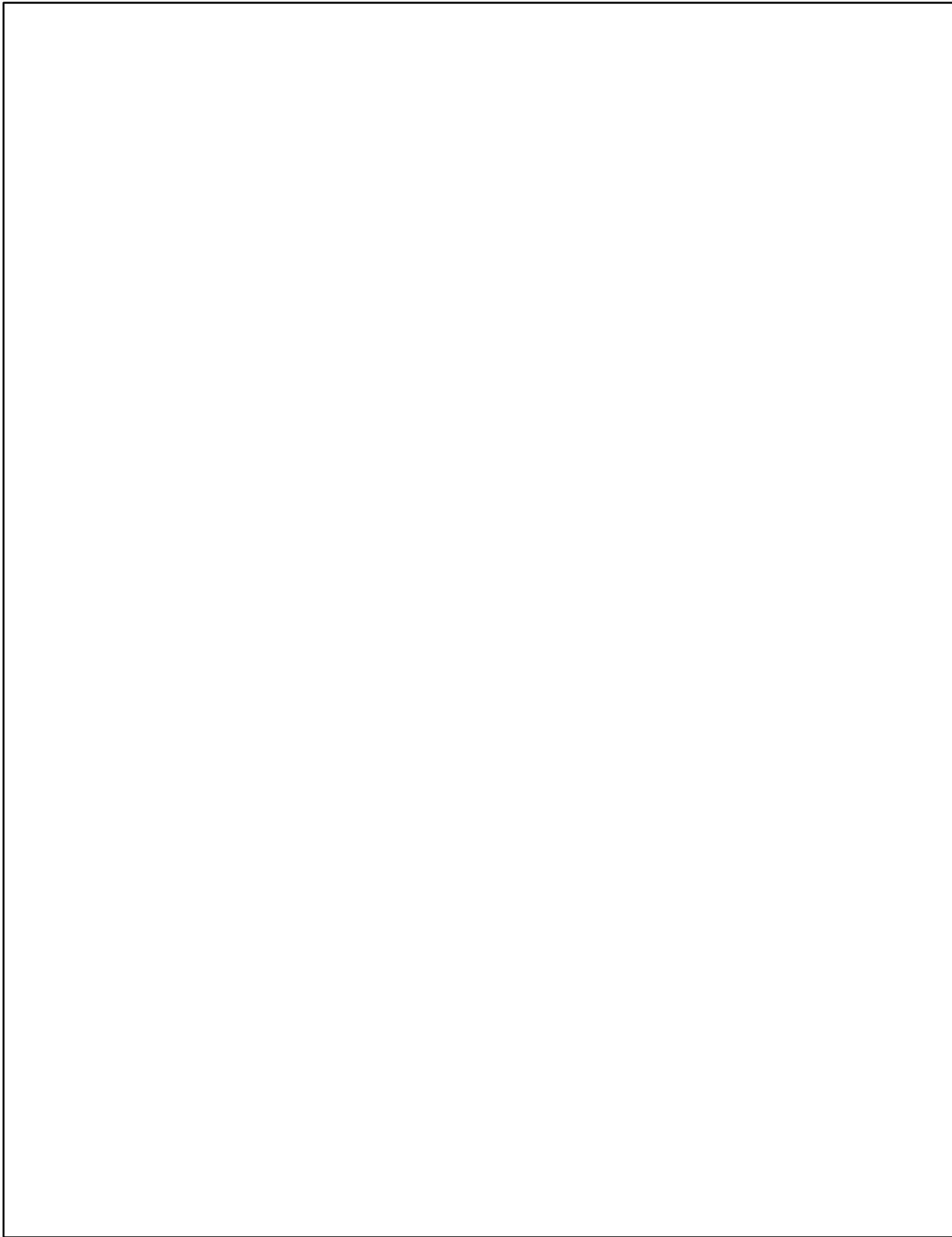
Year 9 Homework Booklet- Task 6
