To follow the Academy's health and safety requirements.

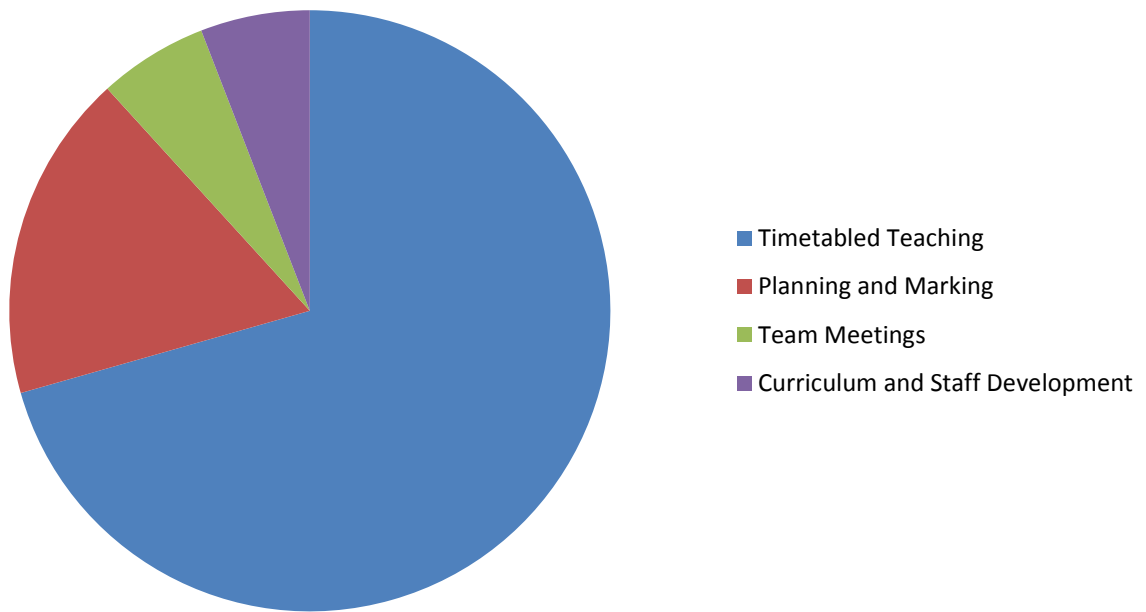
To be committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people and to follow the relevant policies and procedures.
