We are happy to offer an early July 2019 start. Here's the blurb and also do have a look on our website.....


All pupils at SSA study single sciences – and so Physics – from Year 7 to Year 11. All pupils do GCSE's in all three Sciences – and so Physics.

At SSA, if you are a Physics Teacher, you only teach Physics (no having to teach Biology or Chemistry); we believe that strong subject knowledge underpins good teaching of the sciences and accordingly Physicists, Chemists and Biologists only teach their own subjects.

We have 6 Physics teachers so there are plenty of colleagues to talk to about your teaching and you have the opportunity to plan lessons together. We do this through our dedicated Wednesday morning coplanning sessions. We also run a great NQT support programme each year for anyone who may be starting out on their career.

We try to look after our staff. We provide travel loans and have cycle to work, parking permit and childcare voucher schemes. All staff get priority admission to the school for their children. Teachers have lower than average teaching loads and we don't expect them to do cover – so you have time to do the job properly. Our school dinners are well worth eating and you get free coffee all day made by a qualified barista. Last but not least, you get to work with very nice people and pupils.
